

How Lake County School District was able to overhaul its wireless infrastructure and find a trusted partner in the process.

The Client

Located in the mountains of central Colorado, Lake County School District is the highest elevation school district in America at 10,500 ft. The district services 1200 users in total (1000 students and 200 faculty and staff). The district contains four different schools.

DJ Nephew took over as IT director for the district in February 2020. With part-time assistance from techsavvy teachers, D.J. oversees "everything that plugs in, lights up, or beeps." When D.J. started working for the district, he was tasked almost immeditely with upgrading the district's WiFi. Using E-Rate funding and a competitive bidding process, D.J. was introduced to Pine Cove Consulting and Ruckus Wireless. D.J. was not planning on using Ruckus for the upgrade but after meeting with Pine Cove and Ruckus, he was sold.
